Dear Parents / Guardians.

Arrangement of Face-to-face Class Resumption After Easter Holidays

Our school will resume online classes on 21st April after our Easter holidays, and after the completion of the core subject examinations of the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE), S.1 to S.5 will resume half-day face-to-face classes on 3rd May. Students should wear neat and tidy summer uniforms to school. At the same time, S.4 and S.5 will resume online classes in the afternoon. Please refer to Appendix 1 for the schedule of the afternoon online classes for S.4 and S.5 and the supplementary class for S.5; Appendix 2 for the latest amended school calendar. However, since our school will be used as an examination venue by the HKEAA on 5th and 13th May, S.1 to S.5 students will attend online lessons during these two days.

According to the announcement of the Education Bureau on 11th April, all staff and students of the school must undergo a rapid antigen test (RAT) every day before returning to school. The test should be carried out every morning, and only staff and students obtaining negative test results are allowed to return to school for work or lessons. Parents should arrange testing for their children every day before returning to school.

After completing the test, students should fill in and bring the "Rapid Antigen Test Record Sheet" (Appendix 3) signed by parents/guardians to school. On 3rd May, students can record their RAT test results either on the student handbook or on the record sheet. The class teacher will check whether students have filled in the information with parents' signatures and will confirm that students are tested negative. If there is any problem with the result record, the student concerned should go to the general office, and the school will call his/her parents for follow-up. If RAT has not been completed before returning to school, the school will give the student concerned a RAT test kit and assist him/her in conducting the test by himself/herself. The school will conduct spot checks and ask the student concerned to re-test to protect the health and safety of teachers and students.

Although the pandemic has begun to subside and the government has gradually relaxed the disease preventive measures, the pandemic situation has still not yet stabilised. Parents should be vigilant about their children's health conditions and should act promptly in the following situations:

- a) If your child has a fever, respiratory symptoms or sudden loss of taste or smell, etc., he/she must seek medical advice immediately.
- b) If your child is confirmed with COVID-19, parents must inform the school immediately.
- c) If your child is defined as a close contact of a confirmed case, he/she should be put under quarantine/isolation / take COVID-19 test as instructed by CHP, and should not return to school and have to inform the school immediately.
- d) If your child is defined as "persons subject to compulsory testing", he/she must undergo virus testing during the specified period as instructed by CHP, and obtain a negative test result before returning to school. While awaiting the results, your child should undergo RAT. If the RAT result is negative, he/she can return to school to study (including on the day of testing). The school is strongly concerned about the health and safety of each student. Thus, parents are advised not to let their children go to overcrowded places unless necessary. Please remind your children to pay attention to personal hygiene, wash hands frequently, and avoid touching eyes, noses, and mouths with hands. Help your children maintain a healthy lifestyle, keep strong, and strengthen their immune systems. If your child has travelled outside Hong Kong, he/she must report the detailed time and place of departure to the school and comply with quarantine/isolation requirements as instructed by the Department of Health.

(Monthly record, can be attached to the student handbook)

- 1. Parents/Guardians should take their children's temperature every day before going to school. For normal body temperature range, please refer to the "Reference Range for Temperature Screening" in the "Guidance Note on Monitoring of Body Temperature" by the Centre for Health Protection. Please browse https://www.chp.gov.hk/files/pdf/guidance_note_on_monitoring_of_body_temperature.pdf. When the student has a fever, he/she must not attend school and should consult a doctor promptly, apply for sick leave, stay at home and take rest.
- 2. Parents/guardians have to assist their children to complete a Rapid Antigen Test every morning. Students can only return to school after getting negative results. If tested positive, they must not go to school but should inform the school of their positive results as soon as possible and stay at home. They should also report to the Department of Health as soon as possible within 24 hours via the "Declaration System for individuals tested positive for COVID-19 using Rapid Antigen Test" (https://www.chp.gov.hk/ratp/#).
- 3. Parents/Guardians should record their children's temperature and results of RAT daily, and sign on the record sheet. The record sheet should be returned to school staff/class teacher for checking.
