Dear Parents / Guardians,

Our Students' Contraction of COVID-19

Our school received a notification that a Secondary 1 student was initially diagnosed with COVID-19, and the student last entered our campus on 30th June, 2022. Based on the advice provided by CHP, our school has further strengthened the cleansing and disinfection of the school premises.

As the epidemic situation shows signs of a rebound, our school will continue to strictly put in place various anti-epidemic measures stipulated in the 'Health Protection Measures for Schools' issued by the EDB and the 'Health Advice to Schools for the Prevention of COVID-19' issued by the CHP, as well as all other measures against the pandemic.

Parents should continue to take precautionary measures for COVID-19, pay attention to the health conditions of their children and arrange for them to complete an RAT every school day before returning to school. If children have tested positive, they should not return to school and should report this to the school immediately. Taking into account the increasing number of outbreaks of upper respiratory tract infection (URTI) reported recently and the symptoms of URTI being similar to that of COVID-19, if students have a fever or respiratory symptoms, they should not return to school regardless of their RAT results. If children feel unwell (even if the symptoms are very mild), they should seek medical advice promptly so as to receive appropriate diagnoses and treatments early.
